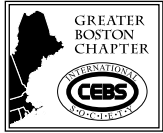


Greater Boston Chapter of ISCEBS Scholarships for CEBS



The Greater Boston Chapter of the International Society of Certified Employee Benefit Specialists (ISCEBS) is pleased to announce that scholarships will be available

to students who wish to pursue their Certified Employee Benefit Specialist (CEBS) designation. Scholarships will be considered as the applications are received at board meetings. The scholarship will pay for 100% of the cost of study materials and testing. There is a maximum of two scholarships awarded per person per calendar year. The overall maximum number of scholarships available for all applicants each calendar year is five.

Each scholarship application must include the following items:

- Cover letter describing why you require assistance toward professional development and certification that your employer does not provide reimbursement, or that you are unemployed
- Must have passed at least one CEBS test previously—provide copy of pass certification letter
- Resumé and work history
- Letter of recommendation from employer or three references if not employed.

All applications will be reviewed by the entire board. A telephone interview will be scheduled with finalists. Written approval and final instructions will be provided to successful applicants. This is a “reimbursement scholarship.” The successful applicants must pass the exam, and then submit copy of receipt and pass notice for reimbursement.

THE DECISIONS OF THE GREATER BOSTON CHAPTER BOARD ARE FINAL.

Limitations and Exclusions

1. An applicant will be considered for no more than two courses for the scholarship program in any calendar year.
2. In order to receive reimbursement, registration for the corresponding exam must be made when study materials are ordered. Exams must be taken within 12 months of the date of registration.
3. You must pass the exam to obtain the scholarship reimbursement. Retake charges will not be reimbursed.
4. As study materials change, it is suggested that you not order study materials further in advance than you can complete in one year. A second set of study materials for the same exam will not be considered for reimbursement.
5. Charges to transfer an exam to another quarter will not be reimbursed.
6. Scholarship awards are determined solely at the discretion of the Greater Boston Chapter board.
